LOTUS ADVOCACY PROGRAM

The Center for Violence Prevention is a 30 day emergency domestic violence shelter and sexual assault crisis center that serves women and children through therapy, case management, court advocacy, and other services as needed.

CVP provides outreach services to men, women, and children who are victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

The Tower is a long term program for human trafficking victims that serves women and children through different forms of therapy, case management, life skills, and court advocacy.

The Lotus Advocacy Program is a three tier program that provides volunteer opportunities with the Center for Violence Prevention and The Tower to community members. Options that span from construction to hospital advocacy, from facilitating life skills training to providing childcare and many things in between.

Each phase builds onto the one before with each tier having its own specialized training.

White Lotus • Tier One

Allows community members to take part in staff supervised events.

- Court Advocacy: Sit with staff and the client to offer support during court proceedings.
- Child Care: Assist with parties and other activities
- Events: Information booths, family events, and charity events.
- Event Watch: Informs staff of upcoming events that CVP could be a part of.
- Pantry Assistance: Food, pantry, and toiletry drives and organization
- Skill Sharing: Plumber, Auto Mechanics, Basic Computing, Creative writing, etc.

Pink Lotus • Tier Two

Allows community members to take part in events unsupervised by staff as well as being able to monitor the white lotus members.

- Court Advocacy: Provide client support during court without staff present.
- Events: Run information booths and assist with charity events.
- Marketing Strategy: Pass out posters and brochures. Assist with online content and developing a larger social media platform through shares and likes.

Achieved all that can be achieved.

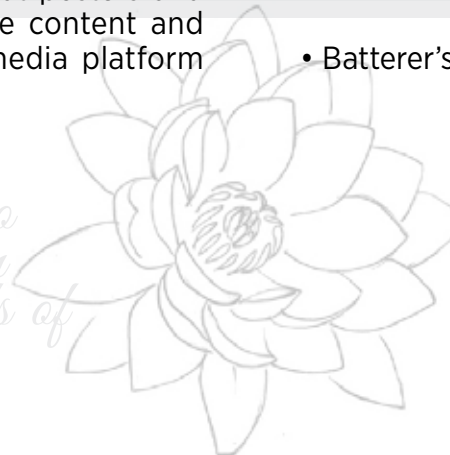


Gold Lotus • Tier Three

First responders to victims in times of crisis, as well as assisting and advocating for our human trafficking victims. They supervise White and Pink LAP member activity.

- Hospital Advocates: respond to victims at the hospitals 24 -hours a day and assist them through a time of crisis.
- Human Trafficking Advocates: Mentor and skill share.
- Batterer's Intervention Program Instructor
